Temporary Storage Container Application/Permit

The City of Franklin, Tennessee, in accordance with Section 17-111 of the Franklin Municipal Code, hereby grants permission for _____ to place a temporary storage container at the following location: _____,

Within the City limits of Franklin, for a period of no longer than thirty (30) days. The \$100.00 permit fee has been paid, and a \$1,000.00 surety bond has been posted. After a period of thirty (30) days, this permit shall expire and be VOID, unless the permit is renewed and approved by the City of Franklin Street Director or his/her Designee.

CONDITIONS:

The Responsible Party agrees to adhere to the guidelines outlined in the Franklin Municipal Code 17-111. Failure to secure a temporary storage container permit or to abide by its conditions shall subject the violator to the penalties in Section 17-114 of the Franklin Municipal Code. When violation has been determined, the City of Franklin Street Director or his/her Designee shall issue a "Notice of Non-Compliance," and if corrective measures are not taken within five (5) business days from the date of the notice, the temporary storage container shall be removed from the site at the Responsible Party's expense, a penalty will be assessed, and the original permit shall be VOID. If the Responsible Party comes into compliance and requests additional time to keep the dumpster in place, the original permit will be extended.
