## Application for Excavation/Road Bore Permit

1) Name, address, phone and email of person, firm, corporation, or association for whom the work is to be done.

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2) Name, address, phone and email of the person, firm, corporation, or association who is to perform the actual excavation, cutting or boring.

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3) Intended location of the excavation, cut, or bore. Site plan to include measurements and dimensions.

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4) State the purpose of the proposed excavation, cut, or bore.

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5) The undersigned applicant does hereby agree to perform all work relating to the proposed excavation, cut, or bore in accordance with all the laws and ordinances pertaining to such work, including but not limited to Title 16-201 through 16-209 of the Franklin Municipal Code.

6) The undersigned applicant does hereby agree to post a bond in such a manner as deemed adequate to insure the excavation, cut, or bore, proof of which will be due at the time the application is made. (\$10,000.00 minimum)



- 7) Further, the undersigned applicant must attach hereto a certificate of insurance indicating that it is insured against claims for damages for personal injury as well as against claims for property damage which may arise from or out of the performance of the work to be performed in accordance with the terms of this application, whether such performance be by the applicant itself, its subcontractor, or anyone directly or indirectly employed by it. Such insurance shall cover collapse, explosive hazards, and underground work by equipment on the street, and shall include protection against liability arising from completed operations. The amount of the insurance shall be \$1,000,000 and the liability insurance for bodily injury shall be not less than \$200,000 for each person and \$300,000 for each accident, and for property damages not less than \$500,000 for any one incident.
- 8) The undersigned applicant does hereby agree to pay a \$100 application fee at the time the application is made. The applicant may request a thirty (30) day extension.
- 9) The undersigned applicant agrees to restore the public street or other public place in which it makes an excavation, cut, or bore to its original condition including resurfacing.
- 10) In case of an unreasonable delay in restoring the public street or other public place in which excavation, cut, or bore was made, the undersigned applicant further agrees that the City may perform the restoration work and charge the expense of the same to the applicant, by using the cash or check, or call the terms of the Letter of Credit or Bond, provided the City gives the applicant twenty-four (24) hour notice of its intention to do so. Upon completion of restoration work by the City of Franklin, any remaining balance shall be returned to the applicant.
- 11) The undersigned applicant agrees to utilize sufficient and proper barricades and lights so as to protect person and property from injury by or because of the excavation, cut, or bore being made. If any sidewalk is blocked by any such work, a temporary pedestrian walkway shall be provided which shall be safe to travel and convenient for users.
