




## RESOLUTION

The Beer Board of the City of Franklin, Tennessee, hereby adopts these guidelines for the punishment of permit holders found guilty of sales of beer to minors, in violation of Section 8-223 (5) of the Franklin Municipal Code and T.C.A. Section 57-5-301. The imposition of penalties shall be within the sole discretion of the Beer Board. These guidelines are meant to insure fairness and consistency among persons charged with the same offense, but the Board may depart from these guidelines whenever the evidence indicates that particular aggravating or mitigating circumstances exist. The Board may also add conditions to any penalty such as probation, additional training of employees, etc.

1. First Offense: 14 day suspension of license and/or, at the option of the Board, imposition of the lesser of a \$1,500 penalty or the maximum penalty constitutionally allowable.
2. Second Offense: Suspension of permit for 60 days.
3. Third Offense: Permanent revocation and ban on re-applying for one year.
