Dog Park Rules & Regulations

Both dog parks have a section for small dogs under 30 pounds and a section for those over 30 pounds. Please utilize the appropriate section for the safety of your dog and others.

Enter & play at your own risk! Remain with your dog(s) at all times. You are solely responsible and liable for any and all injuries and/or damages caused by your dog(s).

Parks are open from dawn until dusk.

Dogs must have current license and vaccinations and be over the age of four (4) months.

Dogs must be off-lease while inside the dog parks. Dogs must wear a collar with identification at all times inside the dog parks.

Your dog must be restrained by a chain or leash not exceeding six (6) feet in length when outside the dog park fence.

Do not bring strollers, carriages, baby carriers, bicycles, scooters, children's toys, food, dog toys, dog treats or dog food into the dog park. Tennis balls are allowed.

Bring no more than three (3) dogs into the dog parks at any one time per owner.

Know your dog's limitations and abilities.

Pick up and properly dispose of your dog's feces both in and around the dog parks.

The pond at The Park at Harlinsdale Farm contains treated effluent water and is strictly prohibited for use by animals or humans.
