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About

The National Citizen Survey™ (The NCS™) is a collaborative effort between National Research Center, Inc. (NRC) and the International City/County Management Association (ICMA). The survey and its administration are standardized to assure high quality research methods and directly comparable results across The NCS communities. Communities conducting The NCS can choose from a number of optional services to customize the reporting of survey results. Franklin’s Comparisons by Demographic Subgroups is part of a larger project for the City and additional reports are available under separate cover. This report discusses differences in opinion of survey respondents by age, sex, ethnicity and race, housing tenure (rent or own) and housing unit type (attached or detached).

Understanding the Tables

For most of the questions, one number appears for each question. Responses have been summarized to show only the proportion of respondents giving a certain answer; for example, the percent of respondents who rated the quality of life as “excellent” or “good,” or the percent of respondents who participated in an activity at least once. It should be noted that when a table that does include all responses (not a single number) for a question that only permitted a single response does not total to exactly 100%, it is due to the common practice of percentages being rounded to the nearest whole number.

The subgroup comparison tables contain the crosstabulations of survey questions by selected respondent characteristics. Chi-square or ANOVA tests of significance were applied to these breakdowns of survey questions. A “p-value” of 0.05 or less indicates that there is less than a 5% probability that differences observed between groups are due to chance; or in other words, a greater than 95% probability that the differences observed in the selected categories of the sample represent “real” differences among those populations. As subgroups vary in size and each group (and each comparison to another group) has a unique margin of error, statistical testing is used to determine whether differences between subgroups are statistically significant. Statistical testing was not performed on multiple response questions.

Each column in the following tables is labeled with a letter for each subgroup being compared. The “Overall” column, which shows the ratings for all respondents, also has a column designation of “(A)”, but no statistical tests were done for the overall rating.

For each pair of subgroups ratings within a row (a single question item) that has a statistically significant difference, an upper case letter denoting significance is shown in the cell with the larger column proportion. The letter denotes the subgroup with the smaller column proportion from which it is statistically different. Subgroups that have no upper case letter denotation in their column and that are also not referred to in any other column were not statistically different.

For example, in Table A below, respondents age 55 and over (C) gave significantly higher rating to the overall quality of life than those age 18 to 34 (A) and 35 to 54 (B), as denoted by the “A B” listed in the cell of the ratings for those 55+. This was also true of women (A) over men (B); people who were white alone, not Hispanic (A) over those who were Hispanic and/or other race (B); homeowners (B) over renters (A); and those living in detached housing (A) over those living in attached housing (B).

Findings

Notable differences between demographic subgroups included the following:

- Community members aged 18-34 tended to give higher ratings than those who were older to several aspects of Mobility, such as ease of walking, availability of paths and walking trails, traffic enforcement, street lighting and snow removal. Residents who were 35 and older were more likely than others to participate in several aspects of Community Engagement, including doing a favor for a neighbor, attending or watching a local public meeting or voting in local elections. Additionally, community members younger than 55 were more likely to communicate with the City of Franklin via social media (Facebook, Twitter, Instagram), while community members older than 35 were more likely to communicate in person or on the phone.
- Female residents tended to give higher ratings than male residents to aspects of Mobility, including ease of travel in Franklin (via car, bicycle, walking), traffic flow, traffic signal timing and sidewalk maintenance. Female residents also were more likely to favorably rate recreation programs or classes and recreation centers or facilities. In addition, female residents awarded higher marks for Franklin as a place to visit and to work than their male counterparts.
- Residents who were white alone, not Hispanic were more likely to award positive ratings to safety (overall feeling of safety and in Franklin's downtown/commercial area during the day), than residents who were Hispanic and/or another race. These residents also tended to give higher scores to city parks, recreation programs or classes and recreation centers or facilities. In contrast, community members who identified as Hispanic and/or another race were more likely than their counterparts to work in Franklin and believed the economy would have a positive impact on their income. Residents who were Hispanic and/or another race were also more likely to communicate directly with the City of Franklin by almost all methods, including in person, via mail and email, and via social media (Facebook, Twitter, Instagram and Nextdoor).
- Respondents who owned their home gave higher ratings than renters to several aspects of Community Engagement: opportunities to participate in social events and activities, to volunteer and to participate in community matters. They were also more likely to have volunteered their time in Franklin, done a favor for or visited with a neighbor. However, respondents who rented their home were more likely to be satisfied with the City's management of growth. Residents who rented tended to give more favorable marks to some aspects of Mobility (ease of public parking, ease of travel by public transportation and availability of paths and walking trails).
- Residents living in detached homes were more likely than residents living in attached homes to positively rate several City services related to Natural Environment (garbage collection, recycling, yard waste pick-up and drinking water). Those living in detached homes reported higher rates of using Franklin recreation centers or public libraries, visiting a neighborhood or City park, attending a City-sponsored event or contacting Franklin elected officials to express their opinion. However, residents living in attached homes tended to give higher marks than their counterparts to the overall feeling of safety in the city and were more likely to recommend living in Franklin to someone who asked.
