A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE VALUES AND GUIDING PRINCIPLES OF PUBLIC PROCUREMENT AS DEVELOPED BY THE NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF GOVERNMENTAL PURCHASING

WHEREAS, the National Institute of Government Purchasing ("NIGP"), in collaboration with key stakeholder organizations, has developed the Values and Guiding Principles of Public Procurement attached hereto for support or adoption, and has introduced such Values and Guiding Principles to chapters of NIGP, stakeholder organizations, local governments and practitioners; and

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin, Tennessee is an agency member of NIGP; and

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin, Tennessee wishes to express its support for the aforementioned Values and Guiding Principles, and its support for the ongoing efforts to develop Standards of Practice for Public Procurement;


