

RESOLUTION 2017-42

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A REVISED VENDOR PROTEST PROCEDURE FOR CITY OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE PROCUREMENTS NOT PERTAINING TO THE DESIGN AND/OR CONSTRUCTION OF NEW INFRASTRUCTURE AND FACILITIES**

**WHEREAS**, on March 8, 2011, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin adopted Resolution No. 2011-10, a resolution adopting a vendor protest procedure for City procurements not pertaining to new construction; and

**WHEREAS**, on January 14, 2014, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin adopted Resolution No. 2014-07, a resolution adopting a vendor protest procedure for City procurements not pertaining to new construction; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen believes it is in the best interest of the City of Franklin to implement a revised procedure for evaluating and responding to vendor protests for procurements not pertaining to the design and/or construction of new infrastructure and facilities in order to update the vendor protest procedure.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The vendor protest procedure for City procurements not pertaining to new construction adopted by Resolution No. 2014-07, and any and all subsequent changes or revisions, are hereby repealed in their entirety. In place thereof, the vendor protest procedure for City of Franklin procurements not pertaining to the design and/or construction of new infrastructure and facilities, attached as Exhibit A hereto, is adopted.

Section 2. Changes or revisions to the procedure hereby adopted shall be made only by resolution of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin.

Section 3. The effective date of the procedure hereby adopted shall be immediate upon passage and adoption of this resolution, the public welfare and the welfare of the City requiring it.
